Second Phase of the Wards Corner Sanitary Sewer Infrastructure Improvements to begin in January

Dear Valued Customer,


The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities has hired Gaston Brothers Utilities to begin the second phase of a \$4.4 million project to replace aging sewer pipes and provide fully resurfaced streets in the area shown on the map to the right.

In January 2012, construction will begin on Newport Avenue and last through the summer; work on the remaining residential streets will follow and is expected to be finished by Summer 2013.

The City and our contractor will do our best to minimize the unavoidable disruptions associated with the construction.
