Project Bulletin Sewer Repair Newport Avenue

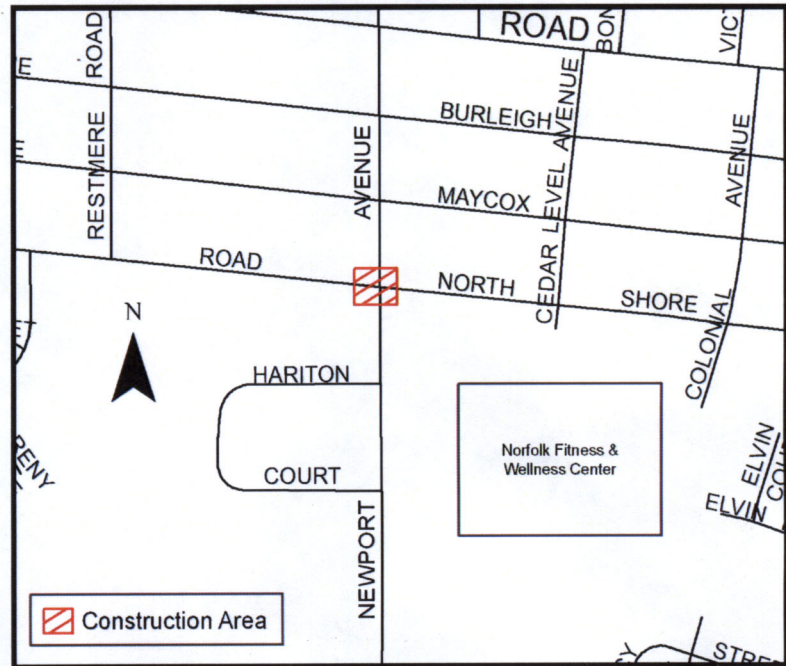

The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities is planning to begin a sewer repair project on Tuesday, February 9th in the Newport Avenue and North Shore Road intersection. All construction activities will take place within the City right-of-way shown on the map at right. Repair work is anticipated to last approximately one month.

Sewer service in your neighborhood will not be disrupted by this repair project. During construction, the intersection will be closed to traffic and signs will guide motorists around the construction area.



The City and our contractor, KevCor, will do our best to minimize the unavoidable disruptions associated with the construction.
